VILLAGE OF GIBBONS FORMED INTO A TOWN

Whereas the Council of the Village of Gibbons has, by resolution, made a request to have the Village formed into a Town and has furnished satisfactory proof that the requirements requisite to the formation of a Town have been complied with:

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Lieutenant Governor in Council, pursuant to section 14, subsection (1), clause (d) of The Municipal Government Act, orders that the Village of Gibbons be formed into the Town of Gibbons, effective April 1, 1977, to consist of the lands described in the attached Appendix.

APPENDIX

All of the north-east quarter of section 10; that portion of the north-west quarter of section 10 lying east of the Sturgeon River and southerly of the south-westerly limit of Road Plan 2924 N.Y.; and all that portion of the south-east quarter of section 10 lying west of the westerly limit of Road Plan 1451 P.X.

Excepting thereout: all that portion as described in Certificate of Title Number 762204233.

All that portion of the south-east quarter of section 15 lying south and east of Road Plan 2073 J.Y.

Excepting thereout: *Firstly*, all that portion of the north-south road widening as shown on Road Plan 2073 J.Y. lying to the west of the east boundary of the south-east quarter of section 15, and *Secondly*, all that portion of the Canadian Northern Western Railway as shown on Registered Railway Plan 4515 A.Q. which lies to the east of the production northerly and southerly of the west limit of the road widening as shown on Road Plan 2073 J.Y.

All of the above described lands lying in township 56, range 23, west of the fourth meridian.

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.
