Edmonton, Tuesday, December 31st 1912.

The Executive Council has had under consideration a report from the Hon. the Minister of Municipal Affairs, bearing even date, stating that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or Rural Municipality, and that the said area contains not less than twenty-five occupied dwelling-houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of the Village Act, caused Notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post Office, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village at the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting such Notices.

The Minister further reports that such Notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof.

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that under the provisions of Section 4 of the Village Act, all of Section Nine (9), Township Thirty-one (31), Range Fourteen (14), West of the Fourth Meridian, be established a Village; that the Village be given the name of HANNA; that William Cowell Stirling of Hanna, Alberta, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first Council of the Village; and that the meeting for the nomination of candidates for the office of Councillor shall be held on Monday the Thirteenth day of January, 1913.
