

Regina, Thursday, December 5, 1901.

Under the provisions of The Village Ordinance, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to Order the establishment of the area which may be particularly described as consisting of Section 6 Township 19 Range 24 west of the Fourth Meridian, as a Village; that the Village be given the name of High River; that Walter Bavis, of High River, Alberta, be appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of an Overseer for the said Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Monday the Twenty-third day of December, A.D. 1901.
