Upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Public Works, bearing even date, the Executive Council advises the establishment of the area which may be particularly described as consisting of Section 6 Township 19 Range 28 west of the Fourth Meridian, as a Village, under the provisions of The Village Ordinance in that behalf-- That the Village be given the name of High River; and that Walter Bavis, of High River, Alberta, be appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of an Overseer for the said Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Monday the Twenty-third day of December, A.D. 1901.

To His Honour

The Lieutenant Governor in Council,

The undersigned has the honour to report that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City or Town or rural Municipality and that the said area contains not less than fifteen dwelling houses, he has in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Ordinance, being Chapter 25 of 1901, caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, announcing the intention to establish the said area as a Village after the expiration of Thirty days from the date of the posting of such notices:

That such notices were posted at least Thirty days prior to the date hereof :

The undersigned therefore recommends that, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Ordinance, the Section 6 Township 19 Range 28 West of the Fourth Meridian be established as a Village; that the name of the Village be H I G H R I V E R ; that Walter Bavis, of High River, Alberta, be appointed a Returning Officer to act at the election of an Overseer for the said Village; and that the election for such Overseer be held on Monday the Twenty-third day of December, 1901.
