ORDER IN COUNCIL NO. 494-57 AMENDED

Edmonton, Tuesday, April 23, 1957,

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated April 15th, 1957, stating that:

Whereas order in council 494-57 was issued on March 27th, 1957, incorporating the New Town of Hinton; and

Whereas a portion of the west half of section 9, township 51, range 25, west of the fifth meridian, was inadvertently omitted from the list of lands recommended for inclusion within the said new town; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable that the said portion of the west half of the said section 9, township 51, range 25, west the the fifth meridian be included within the said new town;

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that:

(1) Order in council 494-57 be and is hereby amended as to clause 2 by the addition of the following lands, namely:

That portion of the west half of section 9, township 51, range 25, west of the fifth meridian, which lies southerly of the right bank of the Athabasca River.

(2) The above amendment be effective as of the same date and in the same manner as was provided for in order in council 494-57.
