Under the provisions of The Village Ordinance, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order the establishment of all of Section 17 in Township 44 Range 13 west of the Fourth Meridian as a Village under the name of Killam, that Tuesday, the Fifteenth day of January, 1907, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that Frank Nichol, of Killam, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election
