Upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Public Works, the Executive Council advises the establishment of the area which may be particularly described as consisting of all of Section 26, the south half of the south-east quarter of Section 35, the south half of the south-west quarter of Section 35, the east half of the north-east quarter of Section 27 and the east half of the south-east quarter of Section 27 all in Township 5 Range 22 west of the Fourth Meridian, as a Village, under the provisions of The Village Ordinance in that behalf-- that the Village be given the name of Magrath; and that Jasper J. Head, of Magrath, Alberta, be appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of an Overseer for the said Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Wednesday the eleventh day of September, A.D. 1901.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council,

The undersigned has the honour to report that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City or Town or rural municipality and that the said area contains not less than fifteen dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Ordinance, being Chapter 25 of 1901, caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village after the expiration of thirty days from the date of the posting of such notices:

That such notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof:

The undersigned therefore recommends that, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Ordinance, all of Section 26, the South half of the South-East quarter of Section 35, the South half of the South-West quarter of Section 35, the East half of the North-East quarter of Section 27 and the East half of the South-East quarter of Section 27, all in Township 5. Range 22 West of the Fourth Meridian, be established a Village; that the name of the Village be MAGRATH; that Jasper J. Head, of Magrath, Alberta, be appointed a Returning Officer to act at the election of an Overseer for the said Village; and that the election for such Overseer for the said Village be held on Wednesday the ~~twenty-eighth~~ <sup>Eleventh</sup> day
