Upon the application of the Village of Mayerthorpe, in the Province of Alberta, upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Lac Ste Anne No 93, upon reading the consent of the Director of Town and Rural Planning for the Province of Alberta, upon reading the consent of the owner of the property concerned, and upon reading the other material filed.

It is ordered that the following land be detached from the Municipal District of Lac Ste Anne No 93, and that the same be and is hereby annexed to the Village of Mayerthorpe

All that portion of the south-east quarter of section 29, township 57, range 8, west of the fifth meridian, in the Province of Alberta, described as follows.

Commencing at the intersection of the south limit of Fourth Avenue, with the west limit of Fourth Street West, as shown on Subdivision Plan 8371 ET; thence west along the projection westerly in a straight line of the said south limit of fourth Avenue a distance of (300) feet, thence north and parallel to the said west limit of Fourth Street West a distance of 1040 feet, more or less to a point on the projection westerly in a straight line of the noith limit of Second Avenue as shown on said Plan 8371 ET, thence east along the said projection a distance of 300 feet to its intersection with the said west limit of Fourth Street West, thence south along the said west limit of Fourth Street West a distance of 1040 feet more or less to the point of commencement. Containing 716 acres more or less

Reserving unto Her Majesty all mines and minerals together with full power to work the same

This Order shall become effective on the 30th day of December, 1959.
