It is ordered that the following parcel of <u>land be separated</u> from the Village of Millet, in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

* All that portion of the south-east quarter of Section 32, in Township 47, Range 24, west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, shown as <u>Parcel 8</u> upon a plan filed in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan No. 4461 C.L., and containing 19.60 acres, more or less:

Excepting thereout all that portion more particularly described as follows:

2974 Commencing at the north-west corner of said parcel, thence southeasterly along the westerly boundary of said parcel, a distance of 299.1 feet to a point at its intersection with the northerly boundary of Plan No. 2974 A.L.; thence north-easterly, and parallel with the northerly boundary of said parcel, a distance of 180 feet, to a point; thence north-westerly, and parallel with the westerly boundary of said parcel, a distance of 299.1 feet, more or less, to a point on the northerly boundary of said parcel; thence south-westerly, along the said northerly boundary of said parcel, to the point of commencement, and containing 1.24 acres, more or less—

- The land herein described and separated from the said village, containing by admeasurement 18.36 acres, more or less.
