

ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGES. MILLET

Regina, Wednesday, June 17, 1903.

Under the provisions of The Village Ordinance, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to Order the establishment of the south half of Section 32 in Township 47 Range 24 west of the Fourth Meridian as a Village under the name of Millet; that Monday, the Twenty-ninth day of June, 1903, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that W. F. Blades, of Millet, Alberta, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.
