Upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Public Works, dated June 11, 1903, all the requirements of The Village Ordinance with respect to the establishment of Villages having been complied with, the Executive Council advises that, under the provisions of The Village Ordinance in that behalf, the south half of section 32 in township 47 range 24 west of the fourth Meridian be established as a Village under the name of Millet; that Monday the twenty-ninth day of June, 1903, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that W.F. Blades, of Millet, Alberta, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The undersigned has the honour to report that, having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or rural Municipality and that the area contains not less than fifteen dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Ordinance, caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the area, one of which was the Post Office, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village after the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting such notices:

He further reports that the said notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof :

The undersigned therefore begs to recommend that, under the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Ordinance, the South half of Section 32 in Township 47 Range 24 West of the Fourth Meridian be established as a Village; that the Village be given the name of M I L L E T ; that W. F. Blades, of Millet, Alta., be appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of an Overseer for the said Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Monday the 29th day of June, 1903.
