Upon the application of A. A. Kaiser, upon hearing counsel for the applicant and for the Town of Olds, and upon reading the material filed:

It is ordered that legal subdivision 7 and the nine acres of legal subdivision 8 lying west of the right-of-way of the Canadian Pacific Railway, both in Section 5, Township 33, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian, be separated from the Town of Olds, subject to the provisions of Section 86a of The Public Utilities Act.

And it is ordered that the said land shall continue liable for the payment of debenture rates upon any debenture indebtedness of the town incurred prior to the date of this order, in the same manner as if such separation had not taken place.
