

ERECTION OF TOWN MUNICIPALITY.

Olds

Regina, Tuesday, June 13, 1905.

Under the provisions of The Municipal Ordinance. His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to Order that a Proclamation do issue proclaiming that on from and after the First day of July, 1905, the Village of Olds be erected into a Town Municipality to be known as the Town of Olds, and that the area of the said Town of Olds consist of the south half of Section 5 in Township 33 Range 1, and the north half of Section 32 in Township 32 Range 1, and the north half of the south half of Section 32 in Township 32 Range 1, all west of the Fifth Meridian in the District of Alberta in the North-West Territories of Canada; and that Henry Squire Steele, of Olds, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election for mayor and councillors for the said Town of Olds.
