Upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Public Works, bearing even date, all the requirements of The Village Ordinance with respect to the establishment of villages having been complied with, the Executive Council advises that, under the provisions of The Village Ordinance in that behalf, the whole of section 36 township 36 range 28 west of the Fourth Meridian be established as a Village under the name of Penhold; that Monday the Sixteenth day of May, 1904, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that Thomas P. Malone, of Penhold, Alberta, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.

To His Honour

The Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The undersigned has the honour to report that, having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or rural Municipality and that the said area contains not less than fifteen occupied dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Ordinance caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post Office, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village after the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting such notices;

He further reports that such notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof :

The undersigned therefore begs to recommend that, under the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Ordinance, the whole of Section 36 in Township 36 Range 28 West of the Fourth Meridian be established as a Village; that the Village be given the name of P E N H O L D ; that Thomas P. Malone, of Penhold, Alberta, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first Overseer for the Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Monday the sixteenth day of May, 1904.
