ORDER IN COUNCIL

Approved and ordered:

Lieutenant Governor

The Lieutenant Governor in Council orders that

(a) effective December 31, 1997, the land described in Appendix A and shown on Appendix B is separated from The County of Ponoka No. 3 and annexed to the Town of Ponoka,

(b) any taxes owing to The County of Ponoka No. 3 on the date of this Order in respect of the annexed land, together with any lawful penalties and costs levied in respect of those taxes, are transferred to and become payable to the Town of Ponoka, and the Town of Ponoka upon collecting those taxes, penalties or costs must pay them to The County of Ponoka No. 3, and

(c) the assessor for the Town of Ponoka must assess in 1998, for the purpose of taxation in 1998, the annexed land and assessable improvements to it.
