ERECTION OF VILLAGES INTO TOWN MUNICIPALITIES.

Under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance 1901 His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to Proclaim that on, from and after the First day of July, 1903, the Village of Raymond be erected into a Town Municipality to be known as the Town of Raymond; that the area of the said Town of Raymond consist of the whole of Sections 7.8. 17 and 18, and those portions of Sections 9 and 16 lying west of a line drawn parallel to and 476 feet perpendicularly distant easterly from the western boundary of the said Sections 9 and 16, all in Township 6 Range 20 west of the Fourth Meridian, in the District of Alberta; and that Edward McCarthy be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election of mayor and councillors for the said Town.
