Upon the application of the Town of Raymond in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the County of Warner No. 5; upon reading the consent of the Director of Town and Rural Planning for this Province; upon reading the consent of the owners of the properties concerned; upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following land be detached from the County of Warner No. 5, and that the same be and is hereby annexed to the Town of Raymond:

Lot 3, in Block 193, together with the adjoining street and lane, according to a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Raymond 4489 J., subject to the covenants and provisions contained in Transfer 1972 L. Excepting thereout all coal.

This order shall be effective as and from the 29th day of December, 1956.
