In the matter of The Public  
Utilities Act, 1923:

And in the matter of an ap-  
plication by Louis Brandley, of  
Raymond, for the separation of  
certain lands from the Town of  
Raymond.

Upon the petition of Louis Brandley for the separation of certain  
lands from the Town of Raymond:

Upon hearing the said application and upon hearing the evidence  
adduced and the exhibits filed on behalf of the applicant, the Town of  
Raymond and the Municipal District of Sugar City, No. 37, and for the  
reasons set forth in the Board's decision:

It is ordered that the following lands, namely:

*Firstly:* All that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 16  
Township 6, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province  
of Alberta, bounded as follows: On the west by the western bound-  
ary of said quarter section; on the east by the eastern boundary  
of the Town of Raymond, Plan 2039 I.; on the north by the production  
easterly of the northern limit of Fourth Street North, and on the  
south by the northern limit of Second Street North, as said streets  
are shown on a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the South  
Alberta Land Registration District as Raymond, 2039 I., containing  
1430 acres (more or less); and

*Secondly:* All that portion of the original road allowance lying  
west of and adjoining the western boundary of the said south-west  
quarter of Section 16 in Township 6, Range 20, west of the Fourth  
Meridian, which is bounded on the north by the southern limit of  
Fourth Street North; on the south by the northern limit of Second  
Street North and on the west by the eastern limit of the lane in  
Block 63 and its production northerly to said Fourth Street North,  
said streets, lane and block being as shown on said Plan Raymond,  
2039 I., the portion of road allowance herein described containing  
0.16 of an acre (more or less):

be, and the same are hereby separated from the Town of Raymond and  
that the same shall be added to and form part of the lands included in  
the Municipal District of Sugar City, No. 37.

And it is further ordered, that the lands so separated, after the 1st  
day of April, 1942, shall no longer be liable for the payment of debenture-  
indebtedness (if any), to which they were subject when comprised in  
the Town of Raymond nor shall they after the said date be liable for any  
rates or taxes in respect of such debenture indebtedness.

This Order shall take effect as and from the date of its publication  
in *The Alberta Gazette*.
