Edmonton, Monday, August 19th, 1912

The Hon. the Attorney-General reports, under date of August 5th, 1912, that he has had under consideration the petition of the ratepayers of the Village of Redcliff for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality, under the provisions of the Municipal Ordinance, 1901;

AND WHEREAS satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said village into a town has been furnished;

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Attorney-General, the Executive Council advises that the Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council do issue, proclaiming that on and after the fifth day of August, 1912, the said Village of Redcliff be erected into a town municipality, in accordance with the said Ordinance, to be known as the TOWN OF REDCLIFF, and that the area of the said town of Redcliff consist of the following lands: ALL that portion of the South half

of Section seventeen (17) lying South of the Right of Way of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company; the whole of Section eight (8) and that part of Section five (5) lying North of the South Saskatchewan River, all in Township thirteen (13), Range six (6), West of the Fourth Meridian, together with all road allowances and public roads lying within or adjoining the limits of the above described lands.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Attorney-General, that Donald McLachlan, of Redcliff, Alberta, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election of Mayor and Councillors for the said town.

AND WHEREAS satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said village into a town has been furnished;


THE UNDERSIGNED THEREFORE RECOMMENDS that Your Honour's Proclamation do issue, proclaiming that on and after the Fifth day of August, 1912, the said village of Redcliff be erected into a town municipality in accordance with the said Ordinance, to be known as the Town of Redcliff, and that the area of the said town of Redcliff consist of the following lands: ALL that portion of the south half of section Seventeen, (17) lying south of the right of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company; the whole of Section Eight, (8) and that part of Section Five, (5) lying north of the south Saskatchewan River, all in Township Thirteen, (13) Range Six (6) West of the Fourth Meridian, together with all road allowances and public roads lying within or adjoining the limits of the above described lands.
