In the matter of The Public Utilities Act, 1923,

And in the matter of an application by the Canadian Pacific Railway Company for the separation of a parcel of land from the Village of Rocky Mountain House.

Upon the application of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company; upon reading the affidavit of James Duff, Superintendent of Townsites for the applicant; upon reading the other material filed; and upon hearing counsel for the applicant and the representative of the Village of Rocky Mountain House:

It is ordered that the following parcel of land be separated from the Village of Rocky Mountain House, in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

All that portion of Legal Subdivision 14, of Section 22, in Township 39, Range 7, west of the Fifth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, which lies to the north of the public highway shown on a plan of record in the Department of Public Works as Plan No. 11934, excepting thereout and therefrom that portion described as:

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the said Legal Subdivision, distant 34 feet northerly from the northern limit of said roadway, thence westerly, and parallel with the northern limit of said roadway, 293 feet; thence northerly and parallel with the eastern boundary of said Legal Subdivision 300 feet; thence easterly, and parallel with the said northern limit of said roadway, to the eastern boundary of the said Legal Subdivision; thence southerly along the said eastern boundary of said Legal Subdivision to the point of commencement—

the land herein described, exclusive of the said exception, comprising 30 acres, more or less.
