FRIDAY, THE SIXTH DAY OF JULY, A.D. 1934.

Before: The Board of Public Utility Commissioners for the Province of Alberta. { In the matter of "The Town and Village Act, 1934";  
And in the matter of an application by the Council of the Village of Rocky Mountain House for the annexation of certain lands to the Village of Rocky Mountain House.

Upon the petition of the Council of the Village of Rocky Mountain House; upon reading the material filed in support of the said petition; upon reading the notices given to the interested parties and no evidence having been submitted against the granting of said petition;

It is ordered that the following parcels of land be annexed to the Village of Rocky Mountain House, in accordance with the provisions of Section 16, of "The Town and Village Act, 1934":

*Firstly*—All that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 23, in Township 39, Range 7, west of the Fifth Meridian, which lies to the north of the northerly boundary of the Canadian National Railway and to the west of the easterly boundary of the Caboose Track of the said Canadian National Railway, together with all that portion of the Road Allowance lying between Sections 22 and 23 in said Township 39, Range 7, west of the Fifth Meridian, which has been closed and cancelled, and which lies to the north of the southerly boundary of the main line of the said Canadian National Railway.

*Secondly*—All that portion of the Road Allowance between Sections 22 and 23, in Township 39, Range 7, west of the Fifth Meridian, lying between the production easterly of the southerly boundary of the north-east quarter of said Section 22, and the northerly boundary of the closed and cancelled portion of said Road Allowance.

This Order shall take effect as from the 1st day of January, A.D. 1935.
