INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SMOKY LAKE INTO  
A TOWN

Edmonton, Tuesday, February 6, 1962.

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated February 1st, 1962, stating that:

Whereas the Council of the Village of Smoky Lake has petitioned to have the village incorporated as a town; and

Whereas a meeting of the electors was held on Monday, January 23rd, 1962, at which meeting a motion was passed to petition for the incorporation of the village into a town; and

Whereas the Village of Smoky Lake contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

Whereas the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, with respect to the formation of a town:

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the request to form the Village of Smoky Lake into a town be acceded to, so that on and from the 1st day of February, 1962, the Village of Smoky Lake shall be known and designated as the Town of Smoky Lake and shall comprise the following lands:

That part of section 16 which lies east of the Canadian National Railway right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 2562 B.S.;

That part of section 21 which lies east of Highway No. 28 as shown on Road Plan 2832 J.Y.;

The south-west quarter of section 22 and that part of the north-west quarter of section 22 lying south of Highway No. 28 as shown on Road Plan 2832 J.Y.;

All of the above described lands contained in township 59, range 17, west of the fourth meridian.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, in accordance with the provisions of section 29 of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, the present Council of the Village of Smoky Lake shall be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake until the 29th day of October, 1962, and that the said Council prepare for the election of a mayor and six councillors to take office on the 29th day of October, 1962, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act in that behalf, and that the terms of office of the mayor and councillors so elected shall be governed by sections 43 and 102 of The Town and Village Act, chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955.
