The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Attorney General, dated November 26th 1908, stating that he has had under consideration the petition of the Ratepayers of the Village of Stoney Plain for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality, under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance 1901.

The Minister further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished.

The Minister therefore recommends that Proclamation of His Honour the Lieutenant Governor do issue proclaiming that on and after the date of such Proclamation the said Village of Stoney Plain be erected into a town municipality to be known as the ~~Town of Stoney Plain~~ and that the limits of the said Town shall be as follows:

Commencing at the North East corner of Section 36, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian, and then running due West along the Northerly limit of said Section 36, Township 52 Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian, ~~and along the Northerly~~ limit of Section 36, Township 52, Range 1 West of the 5th Meridian

Commencing at the North East corner of Section 36, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian, and then running due West along the Northerly limit of said Section 36, Township 52 Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian, and along the Northerly limit of Section 36, Township 52, Range 1 West of the 5th Meridian

to a certain point distant 907½ feet from the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section 36, Township 52, Range 1 West of the 5th Meridian, and thence due South parallel to the 5th Meridian to a certain point on the Southern boundary line of the North half of Section 25, Township 52, Range 1 West of the 5th Meridian; thence due East along the Southern boundary line of the North half of Section 25, Township 52, Range 1 West of the 5th Meridian and the North half of Section 25, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian to the Easterly boundary of the fractional North West quarter of Section 25, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian and then running North along the Easterly boundary line of the fractional North West quarter of Section 25, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian to the Southerly boundary line of Section 36, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian, and thence East along the Southerly boundary line of Section 36, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian to the Easterly boundary line of said Section 36, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian and thence running North along the Easterly boundary line of said Section 36, Township 52, Range 28 West of the 4th Meridian to the place of beginning containing 1195 acres be the same more or less.

The Minister further recommends that John Henry Foerster be named as the returning officer for the holding of the first election of Mayor and Councillors for the said Town.

The Executive Council concur in the recommendations of the Honourable the Attorney General and advise that the same be acted upon.

To His Honour,

The Lieutenant Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report that he has had under consideration the petition of the Rate-payers of the Village of Stoney Plain for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality, under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901.

The undersigned further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished.

The undersigned therefore recommends that Your Honour's Proclamation do issue proclaiming that on and after the date of such Proclamation the said Village of Stoney Plain be erected into a town municipality to be known as the TOWN OF STONEY PLAIN, and that the limits of the said Town shall be as follows:

Commencing at the North East corner of Section 36-52-28 West of the 4th Meridian, and then running due West along the Northerly limit of said Section 36-52-28 West 4th Meridian, and along the Northerly limit of Section 36-52-1 West 5th Meridian to a certain point distant 907½ feet from the North-West corner of the North East quarter of Section 36-52-1 West 5th Meridian, and thence due south parallel to the 5th Meridian to a certain point on the Southern boundary line of the North half of Section 36-52-1 West 5th Meridian; thence due East along the South-



ern boundary line of the North half of Section 25-52-1 West 5th Meridian and the North half of section 25-52-28 West 4th Meridian to the Easterly boundary of the fractional North-West quarter of Section 25-52-28 West 4th Meridian and then running North along the easterly boundary line of the fractional North-West quarter of Section 25-52-28 West 4th Meridian to the Southerly boundary line of Section 36-52-28 West 4th Meridian, and thence East along the Southerly boundary line of Section 36-52-28 West 4th Meridian to the Easterly boundary line of said section 36-52-28 West 4th Meridian and thence running North along the easterly boundary line of said section 36-52-28 West 4th Meridian to the place of beginning containing 1195 acres be the same more or less.

The undersigned further recommends that John Henry Peerster be named as the returning officer for the holding of the first election of mayor and councillors for the said Town.
