And in the matter of an application
by the Canadian Pacific Railway Com-
pany, for the withdrawal of certain
parcels of land from the Town of
Strathmore.

Upon the application of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company, registered owners of the lands affected by this application, for the withdrawal of land from the Town of Strathmore; upon reading the material filed, and upon hearing Counsel for the applicant and for the Town of Strathmore:

It is ordered that the following parcels of land be separated from the Town of Strathmore, in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

Firstly—That portion of the north-west quarter of Section Fourteen (14), in Township Twenty-four (24), Range Twenty-five (25), west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, which lies north of the right of way and station grounds of the Canadian Pacific Railway, and west of the canal right of way, as said right of way and station grounds are shown on a plan filed in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Plan No. Ry. 11, and as the said canal right of way is shown on a plan filed in the said Land Titles Office as Plan No. Irr. 67, the land herein comprised containing seventy-four and forty-five hundredths (74.45) acres, more or less.

Secondly—The north-west quarter of Section Fifteen (15), in Township Twenty-four (24), Range Twenty-five (25), west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, excepting thereout the right of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway, as said right of way is shown on a plan filed in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registra-

tion District as Plan No. Ry. 11, the land herein comprised containing one hundred and forty-seven and seventeen hundredths (147.17) acres, more or less.

Thirdly—Legal Subdivisions Four (4) and Five (5) of Section Thirteen (13), in Township Twenty-four (24), Range Twenty-five (25), west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, the land herein comprised containing eighty (80) acres, more or less.
