



Edmonton, Friday, July 21st, 1911.

The Hon. the Attorney General reports, under date of July 6th, 1911, that he has had under consideration the petition of the Council of the Village of Strathmore, for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901; and whereas satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said vaillage into a town has been furnished.

Upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Attorney General, the Executive Council therefore advise that Your Honour(s) proclamation do issue proclaiming that on and after the sixth day of July, 1911, the said village of Strathmore be erected into a town municipality in accordance with the said Ordinance, to be known as the Town of Strathmore, and that the area of the said town of Strathmore consist of the following lands: All of section fourteen (14); the east half of section fifteen (15); the north east quarter of section ten (10) the north-west quarter of section eleven (11); that portion of the north-east quarter of section eleven (11) lying to the west of the Canadain Pacific Railway right of way; and the west half of the south west quarter of section thirteen (13), all in township twenty-four (24), range twenty-five (25) west of the Fourth Meridian; also all road allowances within the above described area.

Upon the further recommendation of the Hon. the Attorney General, the Executive Council further advise that Eugene Sly, of Strathmore, Alberta, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election of Mayor and Councillors for the said town.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report that he has had under consideration the petition of the Council of the Village of Strathmore, for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901;

And Whereas satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said village into a town has been furnished;

The undersigned therefore recommends that Your Honour's proclamation do issue proclaiming that on and after the sixth day of July, 1911, the said village of Strathmore be erected into a town municipality in accordance with the said Ordinance, to be known as the TOWN OF STRATHMORE, and that the area of the said town of Strathmore consist of the following lands: All of section fourteen,(14); the east half of section fifteen,(15); the north-east quarter of section ten,(10); the north-west quarter of section eleven,(11); that portion of the north-east quarter of section eleven,(11), lying to the west of the Canadian Pacific Railway right of way; and the west half of the south west quarter of section thirteen,(13), all in township twenty-four,(24), range twenty-five,(25), west of the Fourth Meridian; also all road allowances within the above described area.

The undersigned further recommends that Eugene Sly,
