ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGE.

Edmonotn, Friday, March 20, 1908.

Under the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Act, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order the establishment of the south-west quarter of Section 14 Township 24 Range 25 west of the Fourth Meridian, and that part of the north-west quarter of Section 14 Township 24 Range 25 west of the Fourth Meridian lying south-west of the main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway, as a Village under the name of Strathmore; that Monday, the Sixth day of April, 1908, be the day fixed for the election of a Council for said Village; and that William Ellis Brown, of Strathmore, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.
