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FORMATION OF THE TOWN OF SUNDRE

Edmonton, Monday, February 13, 1956.

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order pursuant to the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, that the proposal to form the village of Sundre into a town shall be acceded to so that on and from the 1st day of January, 1956, the Village of Sundre shall be known and designated as the Town of Sundre and shall be comprised of the following lands.

That portion of the north-east quarter of section 33, township 32, range 5, west of the fifth meridian, lying north of the south boundary of registered Plan No. 8542 G.M.

That portion of the north west quarter of section 34, township 32, range 5, west of the fifth meridian, lying west of the west bank of the Red Deer River.

That portion of the west half of section 34, township 32, range 5, west of the fifth meridian, lying east of the Red Deer River and bounded on the south by:

the south limit and its production westerly of registered Plan No. 5117 E. S., the south limit and its production westerly of Block 6 of registered Plan No. 1589 G.Y. and the south limit and its production easterly of registered Plan No. 5314 F. P.;

and bounded on the east by:

the west limit of Road Plan No. 3776 E. Z., the east limit of Block 6 of Registered Plan No. 1589 G. Y. and the east boundary of the said half section.

That portion of the northerly 363 feet of the north east quarter of section 34, township 32, range 5, west of the fifth meridian, lying west of the production south of the east limit of Gilbert Street as shown on Registered Plan No. 4875 F. Q.

That portion of the south half of section 3, township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian, lying east of the Red Deer River, south of the north limit and its production westerly of Registered Plan No. 8576 G. M. and west of the east limit of Gilbert Street as shown on Registered Plan No. 4875 F. Q.

That portion of the south west quarter of section 3, township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian lying west of the west limit of the Red Deer River.

That portion of the north west quarter of section 3, township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian, included in Registered Plans Nos. 5378 F. Q., 6194 G. N., 4835 G. D. and that part of Road Plan No. 9679 Q. lying south of the production westerly of the north limit of Registered Plan No. 4835 G. D. together with that portion of Government Road Allowance in the said north west quarter, which lies to the south of Road Plan No. 9679 Q.

The south east quarter of section 4, township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian.

The south half of legal subdivisions 3 and 4 in section 4, township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian.

Further, that for the purposes of Certificates of Assessment as required by sections 283 and 296 of The School Act, 1952, and section 73 of The Municipal Hospitals Act, this Order shall be deemed to have been in effect as of the 31st day of December, 1955.

Further, that in accordance with the provisions of section 29 of The Town and Village Act, 1952, the present Council of the Village of Sundre shall be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Sundre until the second Monday in March, 1956, and that the said Council shall prepare for the election of a Mayor and six Councillors to take office on the

second Monday in March, 1956, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, in that behalf, and that the terms of office of the Mayor and Councillors so elected shall be governed by the provisions of sections 43 and 98 of The Town and Village Act, 1952.
