application by the Village of  
Sundre for annexation of certain  
lands to the said Village.

Application having been made to The Board of Public Utility Commissioners by the Village of Sundre for an order severing the properties hereinafter described from the Municipal District of Mountain View No. 49 and for the annexation of the said parcels to the Village of Sundre;

And it appearing from the material filed in support of such application that the Municipal District of Mountain View No. 49 and all owners of land included in the parcels which it is proposed to annex have expressly agreed to such severance and annexation;

It is therefore ordered that the following lands, namely.—

*Firstly* All that portion of the south half of section 3, in township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian in the Province of Alberta lying within the following described boundaries: Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of said half section with the easterly limit of Gilbert Street as said street is shown on a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Sundre 4875F.Q; thence north along said limit and its production northerly a distance of 536 feet; thence west parallel with the northerly limit of Stirling Avenue shown on said plan a distance of 330 feet, thence north parallel with said production of said limit of Gilbert Street a distance of 30 feet; thence west parallel with said limit of Stirling Avenue a distance of 626.3 feet more or less to intersection with the production northerly of the westerly limit of Spruce Street shown on said plan 4875F.Q.; thence southerly along said production of said limit of Spruce Street a distance of 203 feet more or less to said northerly limit of Stirling Avenue; thence westerly along said limit of Stirling Avenue and its production westerly to the right bank of the Red Deer River as said river is shown on a plan of survey of the said township approved at Ottawa 8th April, 1905; thence southwesterly along said right bank to the said south boundary of said south half of said section 3; thence east along said south boundary to the point of commencement.

*Secondly*: All that portion of the north half of section 34, in township 32, range 5, west of the fifth meridian in the said Province of Alberta lying within the following described boundaries: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of said north half of section 34 with the production southerly of the said east limit of Gilbert Street shown on said plan 4875F.Q; thence south along said production a distance of 363 feet; thence west parallel with the said north boundary of said half section to the east boundary of the north-west quarter of said section 34; thence south along said east boundary to intersection with the production easterly of the souther-

ly limit of Allen Avenue as same is shown on a plan of record in the said Land Titles Office as Sundre 5314F P.; thence westerly along said production and said limit of Allen Avenue and its production westerly to the right bank of the Red Deer River as shown on a plan of survey of the said township approved at Ottawa 11th September 1918; thence northerly along said right bank to the said north boundary of section 34; thence easterly along said north boundary to the point of commencement; and

*Thirdly:* All that portion of the original road allowance lying between said section 3, in township 33, range 5, west of the fifth meridian which lies between the said right bank of the Red Deer River and the production south across said road allowance of the said east limit of Gilbert Street shown on said plan Sundre 4875F Q.

be severed from the Municipal District of Mountain View No. 49, and that they are hereby annexed to the Village of Sundre pursuant to the provisions of "The Town and Village Act".
