ESTABLISHMENT OF A TOWN MUNICIPALITY.

Edmonton, Friday, June 14, 1907.

Under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order that a Proclamation do issue proclaiming that on, from and after the First day of July, 1907, the Village of Taber be erected into a Town Municipality to be known as the Town of Taber; that the area of the said Town of Taber consist of Section 5 Township 10, the north-west quarter of Section 32, and the north-east quarter of Section 31, that portion of the north-east quarter of Section 32 lying north of the C. P. R. tracks in Township 9 Range 16 west of the Fourth Meridian, excluding that part of the north-east quarter of Section 31 Township 9 Range 16 west of the Fourth Meridian lying south of the C. P. R. tracks; and that David Burbanks, of Taber, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election for Mayor and Councillors for the said Town.
