Before: The Board of Public Utility Commissioners for the Province of Alberta. { In the matter of The Public Utilities Act, 1923,
And in the matter of an application by the Town of Taber and John G. Barton of Taber, in the Province of Alberta, for the withdrawal of two parcels of land from the Town of Taber.

Upon the application of the Town of Taber and John G. Barton, registered owners of the lands affected by this application, for the withdrawal of two parcels of land from the Town of Taber; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following parcels of land be separated from the Town of Taber, in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

Firstly—That portion of the north half of the north-east quarter of Section Thirty-two (32), in Township Nine (9), Range Sixteen (16), west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, which lies to the south of a line drawn parallel with and one hundred and ten (110) feet perpendicularly distant south-easterly from the south-easterly limit of the railway right of way of the Alberta Railway & Coal Company as said right of way is shown on a plan filed in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Railway 21, the land herein comprised containing sixty and twenty hundredths (60.20) acres, more or less.

Secondly—Legal subdivision Nine (9) of Section Thirty-two (32), in Township Nine (9), Range Sixteen (16), West of the Fourth Meridian, the land herein comprised containing Forty (40) acres more or less.
