Under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance 1901, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to Order that a proclamation do issue proclaiming that on, from and after the Fifteenth day of August, 1906, the Village of Vegreville be erected into a Town Municipality to be known as the Town of Vegreville; that the area of the said Town of Vegreville consist of the west half of Section 17, all of Section 18, the south half of Section 19 and the south-west quarter of Section 20, all in Township 52 Range 14 west of the Fourth Meridian; the east half of Section 13, the south-east quarter of Section 24, in Township 52 Range 15 west of the Fourth Meridian in the Province of Alberta; and that Frederic A. Morrison, of Vegreville, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election for mayor and councillors for the said Town. M. J. MACLEOD,
