In the matter of The Public Utilities Act, and in the matter of an application by Clarence L. Starr and Charles Gordon, for the separation of certain portions of the south-west quarter of Section 17, Township 52, Range 14, west of the Fourth Meridian, from the Town of Vegreville.

Upon the application of Clarence L. Starr and Charles Gordon, upon hearing the representatives of all parties interested, and upon reading the material filed:

It is ordered that Blocks "A" and "B", Plan 2643-A.Y., owned by the applicant, Starr, and the ten acre block of land in the south-west quarter of Section 17, Township 52, Range 14, west of the Fourth Meridian, and adjoining the western boundary of said quarter section, and more particularly described in Certificate of Title No. 19 B. 34, standing in the name of Charles Gordon, be separated from the Town of Vegreville, but that the said lands continue to be liable for the payment of any debenture indebtedness of the said town incurred prior to this order in the same manner as if such separation had not been effected.
