The Executive Council has had under consideration a report from the Attorney General, dated August 14th, 1906, with reference to the petition of the Overseer of the Village of Vegreville for the erection of the said Village into a Town Municipality, under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901, stating that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished.

Upon consideration of the foregoing report and on the recommendation of the Attorney General, the Executive Council advises that, under the provisions of the said Ordinance in that behalf, a proclamation do issue proclaiming that on from and after the fifteenth day of August, 1906, the said Village of Vegreville be erected into a town municipality, to be known as the Town of Vegreville; and that the area of the said Town of Vegreville consist of the west half of section seventeen(17), all of section eighteen(18), the south half of Section nineteen(19), and the south-west quarter of section twenty(20), all in township fifty-two(52) in range fourteen(14), West of the fourth Meridian(W.4th M) and the east half of section thirteen(13), and the south east quarter of section twenty-four(24) in township fifty-two(52) in range fifteen(15) West of the fourth Meridian(W.4th M.) in the Province of Alberta; and

that Frederic A. Morrison, of Vegreville, Alberta,
be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of
the first election for mayor and councillors for the
said town.


The undersigned further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished.



Memorandum for the Attorney General :

A petition has been received from the Village of Vegreville, asking for incorporation as a town. A census, which was taken, shows that the population of Vegreville is 457. The limits of the proposed municipality are :-

west half of section 17, all of section 18, the south half of section 19, and the south-west quarter of section 20, all in township 52, in range 14, W. 4th M., and the east half of section 13, and the south east quarter of section 24, in township 52 in range 15, W. 4th M.

All the requirements of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance seems to have been complied with.
