Whereas it has come to the attention of the Board, in the course of hearing an annexation petition filed with the Board on October 1, 1964, by the Town of Vegreville, that certain roadways described hereunder should be separated from the Town of Vegreville and annexed to the County of Minburn No 27

It is ordered that there be separated from the Town of Vegreville, in the Province of Alberta, and annexed to the County of Minburn No 27.

Firstly All of the original government road allowance adjoining the south boundary of the south-west quarter of section 17, township 52, range 14, west of the fourth meridian

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

Secondly All that portion of the original government road allowance adjoining the west boundary of the south-west quarter of section 18, said township and range, which lies south of the production westerly of the south boundary of Plan 750 MC and all that portion of the original government road allowance adjoining the south boundary of the said quarter section which lies west of the production southerly of the west boundary of Plan 2706P and including the intersection of the said road allowances at the south west corner of the said quarter section

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

It is ordered that the lands described aforesaid be separated

This order shall take effect as, on and from the 1st day of January, 1965
