Before: The Board of Public Utility Commissioners for the Province of Alberta.

In the matter of The Town and Village Act, 1923:  
And in the matter of an application by the Town of Vulcan for the annexation of certain lands to the said Town.

Upon the petition of the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the affidavit of A. J. Flood, Secretary-Treasurer for the applicant; upon hearing Norman N. Plummer, LL.B., Solicitor for Mary Marcellus, and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered, that the following parcels of land, being portions of Section 5, Township 17, Range 24, west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, be annexed to the Town of Vulcan in accordance with the provisions of Section 32 of The Town and Village Act, 1934:

*Firstly:* Commencing at the point of intersection of the south-eastern boundary of Plan No. 5277 D.R. with the north-eastern boundary of Atlantic Avenue in Plan No. 5163 C.C., thence north-westerly along the said north-eastern boundary of Atlantic Avenue to the south-eastern boundary of Minerva Street; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of the said Minerva Street to its intersection with the south-western boundary of Railway Avenue; thence south-easterly along the south-westerly limit of Railway Avenue a distance of 150 feet to a point; thence south-westerly in a straight line 150 feet distant south-easterly and parallel with the south-westerly limit of Minerva Street to the point of intersection with the north-eastern boundary of Plan No. 5277 D.R., thence south-easterly along the north-easterly limit of said Plan to the north-east corner thereof; thence south-westerly along the south-easterly limit of said Plan to the point of commencement.

*Secondly:* Commencing at the point of intersection of June Street in Plan No. 7000 A.C. and Atlantic Avenue in Plan No. 4030 A.M., thence north-westerly along the north-easterly limit of Atlantic Avenue a distance of 135 feet to a point; thence south-easterly in a straight line drawn 135 feet north-westerly distant and parallel with the north-west boundary of June Street a distance of 433 feet; thence south-easterly in a straight line 433 feet distant and parallel with the south boundary of Atlantic Avenue a distance of 135 feet to the north-west boundary of June Street; thence north-easterly along the said north-west boundary of June Street to the point of commencement.

*Thirdly:*—All that portion of the south-east quarter of Section 5, Township 17, Range 24, west of the Fourth Meridian, south-east of Marz Street as shown on Plans No. 5163 C.C. and No. 791 B.W., and south-west of Atlantic Avenue as shown on Plan No. 5163 C.C., excepting thereout 3.55 acres registered under Certificate of Title No. 37 K. 43 in the name of the Minister of Public Works for the Province of Alberta.

*Fourthly:*—Commencing at the south-west corner of Lot 6, Block 20, Plan 791 B.W.; thence northerly along the west boundary of said lot to the north-west corner thereof; thence easterly along the south boundary of Lots 5, 3 and 4 of said Block 20, in Plan No. 791 B.W., a distance of 307.5 feet; thence southerly in a straight line along the east boundary of Lot 4, Block 20, and of Garden Avenue, in said Plan No. 791 B.W. to the south boundary of said Block 20; thence easterly in a straight line a distance of 307.5 feet to the point of commencement.

All plans mentioned of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District.

This Order shall take effect as from the date of its publication in *The Alberta Gazette*.
