

PROCLAMATION.

ESTABLISHMENT OF TOWN MUNICIPALITY.

Edmonton, Wednesday, July 20, 1910.

Under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order that a Proclamation do issue proclaiming that on, from and after the Fourteenth day of July, 1910, the Village of Wainwright be erected into a Town Municipality to be known as the Town of Wainwright; that the area of the said Town of Wainwright consist of the south half of Section 6 in Township 45, the south-west quarter of Section 32 and all of Section 31 in Township 44 Range 6 west of the Fourth Meridian, and also all the road allowances lying within or adjoining the said lands; and that Henry Vernon Fieldhouse, of Wainwright, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election of Mayor and Councillors for the said Town.
