
Edmonton, Wednesday, July 20th, 1910.

The Honourable the Attorney General reports under date of July 14th. that he has had under consideration the petition of the Council of the Village of Wainwright for the erection of the said Village into a Town municipality under the provisions of the Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901:

The Honourable Minister further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished:

The Executive Council therefore advise, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Attorney General, that a proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor do issue, proclaiming that on and after the fourteenth day of July, 1910, the said Village of Wainwright be erected into a Town Municipality, to be known as the Town of Wainwright, and that the area of the said Town of Wainwright consist of the South half of Section 6 in Township 45, and the South-west quarter of Section 32, and all of Section 31 in Township 44, all in Range 6, West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, containing by admeasurement one thousand, one hundred and twenty acres, more or less, and also all the road allowances lying within or adjoining the said lands.

The Executive Council further advise that Henry Vernon Fieldhouse, of Wainwright, Alberta, be named as the returning Officer for the holding of the first election of Mayor and Councillors for the said Town.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council:


The undersigned has the honour to report that he has had under consideration the petition of the Council of the Village of Wainwright for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality under the provisions of The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901;

The undersigned further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said village into a town has been furnished;

THE UNDERSIGNED THEREFORE RECOMMENDS that Your Honour's Proclamation do issue proclaiming that on and after the fourteenth day of July, 1910, the said Village of Wainwright be erected into a town municipality to be known as the TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT, and that the area of the said town of Wainwright consist of the south half of section six (6) in township forty-five (45) and the south west quarter of section thirty-two (32) and all of section thirty-one (31) in township forty-four (44), all in Range six (6) West of the fourth principal Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, containing by admeasurement one thousand one hundred and twenty acres, more or less, and also all the road allowances lying within or adjoining the said lands.

The Undersigned further recommends that HENRY
VERNON FIELDHOUSE, of Wainwright, Alberta, be named
as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first
election of Mayor and Councillors for the said Town.
