Upon the application of Edwin Eugene Tory, of Wainwright, in the Province of Alberta, beneficial owner of the land hereinafter described, for the withdrawal of a certain parcel of land from the Town of Wainwright; upon reading the consent of the Grand Trunk Pacific Development Company, Limited, registered owners of said land; upon reading the consent of Joseph Welch, of Wainwright, encumbrancer; upon reading the consent of the Town of Wainwright; upon reading the affidavit of the applicant; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following parcel of land be separated from the Town of Wainwright, in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

The south half of Section 6, in Township 45, Range 6, west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, excepting thereout all that portion of the said land shown on two certain maps or plans of subdivision of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan No. 5721 A.D. and Plan No. 890 A.J., respectively.

The land herein described, exclusive of the said exceptions, containing by admeasurement 142.56 acres, more or less.
