## ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE OF WEMBLEY <sup>P.</sup>

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the provisions of The Village Act in that behalf, that, by order of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated the 3rd day of January, 1928, the following area, namely:

The north half of the north-west quarter of Section 15, Township 71, Range 8, west of the Sixth Meridian, and all that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 22, Township 71, Range 8, west of the

Sixth Meridian, lying south of the northerly boundary of the right-of-way and station grounds of the Edmonton, Dunvegan & British Columbia Railway, as same are shown on a plan registered in the Land Titles Office, Edmonton, as Plan No. 2953 CL., was erected into a village, to be known by the name of the Village of Wembley.
