APPENDIX

Formation of the Summer Village of Chestermere Lake into a Town

- The Summer Village of Chestermere Lake is formed into a town effective March 1, 1993.
- 2. The name of the town is the Town of Chestermere.
- Subject to section 4, the members of the council of the summer village shall continue
 as the council of the town until a general election is held on the third Monday in
 October 1995.
- 4. On September 1, 1993, the size of the council shall increase to a mayor and six councillors and a by-election shall be held not later than October 18, 1993, to elect
 - a) a mayor, and
 - b) any other vacancies on council
