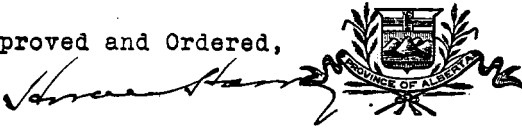

Edmonton, Tuesday, December 1st, 1936.

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated November 28th, 1936, stating that:

WHEREAS the affairs of the Village of COALHURST are under the control of an Official Administrator; and

WHEREAS, due to local conditions, it is deemed necessary to change the status of the said Village of Coalhurst to that of a hamlet;

THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being Chapter 49 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1934, and amendments thereto, that the Village of Coalhurst be and is hereby dissolved as from the 31st day of December, 1936, and that the lands which are now within the boundaries of the said Village of Coalhurst be and are hereby added to/ ^{and} form a part of the area known as Improvement District No. 68, and, commencing with the year 1937, be made subject to taxation under the provisions of The Improvement Districts Act, being Chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, and all amendments thereto.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that the arrears of taxes outstanding and unpaid on the Assessment Roll of the said Village shall be payable as taxes due to the Department of Municipal Affairs in the same way as if the said arrears of taxes had been levied by the said Department of Municipal Affairs

under the provisions of The Improvement Districts Act aforesaid.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that all tools, implements or other property of whatsoever kind now belonging to the said Village of Coalhurst shall become the property of the Department of Municipal Affairs, on, from and after the 1st day of January, 1937, and that ARTHUR FRAYNE, now Official Administrator of the Village of Coalhurst, be and he is hereby appointed the person to adjust the assets and liabilities of the dissolved Village of Coalhurst, in accordance with the provisions of Section 20 of The Town and Village Act.

WHEREAS the affairs of the Village of COALHURST are under the control of an Official Administrator, and

WHEREAS, due to local conditions, it is deemed necessary to change the status of the said Village of COALHURST to that of a hamlet;

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned recommends, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being Chapter 49 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1934, and amendments thereto, that the Village of COALHURST be dissolved as and from the 31st day of December 1936, and that the lands which are now within the boundaries of the said Village of COALHURST be added to and form a part of the area known as Improvement District No.68 and, commencing with the year 1937, be made subject to taxation under the provisions of the Improvement Districts Act, being Chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta 1927, and all amendments thereto. The undersigned also recommends that the arrears of taxes outstanding and unpaid on the Assessment Roll of the said Village shall be payable as taxes due to the Department of Municipal Affairs in the same way as if the said arrears of taxes had been levied by the said Department of Municipal Affairs under the provisions of the Improvement Districts Act aforesaid.

IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED that all tools, implements or other property of whatsoever kind now belonging to the said Village of COALHURST shall become the property of the Department of Municipal Affairs on and after the 1st day of January 1937, and that ARTHUR FRAYNE, now Official Administrator of the Village of COALHURST, be and is hereby appointed the person to adjust the assets and liabilities of the dissolved Village of COALHURST in accordance with the provisions of Section 20 of The Town and Village Act.
