

PROCLAMATION.

ESTABLISHMENT OF TOWN MUNICIPALITY.

Edmonton, Monday, March 6, 1916.

Under the provisions of The Village Act, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor has been pleased to proclaim that on and after the 2nd day of March, 1916, the Village of Drumheller be erected into a Town Municipality in accordance with the said Act, to be known as the Town of Drumheller, and that the area of the Town of Drumheller consist of the following lands: South-east quarter of Section 11, parts south and west of the Red Deer River of Section 12, and that part of the north-west quarter of Section 1 which has been subdivided and registered under Plan Number 6495-A-V, all in Township 29, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian; and that the nomination meeting for the first election of a council for the said town shall be held on Monday, March 27, 1916.
