The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Hon. the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated March 1st, 1916, stating that he has had under consideration the application of the Council of the Village of Drumheller for the erection of the said Village into a Town Municipality under the provisions of the Village Act;


The Hon. the Minister of Municipal Affairs further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished;

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council be issued proclaiming that on and after the 2nd day of March, 1916, the said Village of Drumheller be erected into a Town Municipality in accordance with the said Act, to be known as the Town of Drumheller and that the area of the Town of Drumheller consist of the following lands:

South-east Quarter of Section Eleven (11); parts South and West of the Red Deer River of Section Twelve (12), and that part of the North-west Quarter

of Section One (1), which has been subdivided and registered under Plan Number 6495-A-V, all in Township Twenty-nine (29), Range Twenty (20), West of the Fourth Meridian;

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that the nomination meeting for the first election of a Council for the said Town shall be held on Monday, March 27th, 1916.

The undersigned has the honor to report that he has had under consideration the application of the Council of the Village of Drumheller for the erection of the said Village into a Town Municipality under the provisions of the Village Act,

The undersigned therefore begs to recommend that Your Honour's Proclamation do issue proclaiming that on and after the Second day of March, 1916, the said Village of Drumheller be erected into a Town Municipality in accordance with the said Act, to be known as the Town of Drumheller and that the area of the Town of Drumheller consist of the following lands:

South-east Quarter of Section Eleven (11);
parts South and West of the Red Deer River of Section Twelve(12),
and that part of the North-West Quarter of Section One (1), which

all in Township Twenty-nine (29), Range Twenty (20), West of

And that the nomination meeting for the
