for the annexation of certain
lands.

Upon the application of the Village of Acme, in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Director of Town and Rural Planning for the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Kneehill No. 48; upon reading the consent of the owner of the property concerned; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following land be detached from the Municipal District of Kneehill No. 48, and that the same be and is hereby annexed to the Village of Acme.

Firstly: Parcel "F" in the north-west quarter of section 19, township 29, range 25, west of the fourth meridian, as shown on a plan filed in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Acme 4921HV. Containing 16 acres, more or less

Secondly: Those portions of Thompson Street which adjoin the south boundary of the said Parcel "F" according to plans of record in the said Land Titles Office as Acme 2315AB and 4474EZ. Containing 1.92 of an acre, more or less

Excepting out of all the above land all mines and minerals and the right to work the same

This Order shall become effective on the 30th day of December, 1960
