The Executive Council have had under consideration the report of the Hon. the Minister of Public Works, dated June 16th, that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town, or Rural Municipality and that the said area contains not less than 25 occupied dwelling houses, he has in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of the Village Act caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post Office announcing the intention to establish the area at the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting such notices.

The Minister further reports that such notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof.

The Executive Council therefore, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Minister of Public Works advise that under the provisions of Section 4 of the Village Act, legal sub-divisions six seven, ten and eleven in Section nineteen, Township Twenty-nine, Range 25, west of the 4th Meridian be established a Village: that the Village be given the name of Acme: that Mr. J. Fisher William of Acme Alberta, be returning officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first council of the Village and that the meeting for nomination of candidates for the office of Councilor: shall be held on Tuesday the 5th day of July, 1910.


TO HIS HONOR
THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

The undersigned has the honor to report that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or Rural Municipality and that the said area contains not less than twenty-five (25) occupied dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of the Village Act caused Notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post-Office announcing the intention to establish the area at the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting such Notices.

He further reports that such Notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof.

The undersigned therefore begs to recommend that under the provisions of Section 4 of the Village Act, legal subdivisions six (6), seven (7), ten (10) and eleven (11) in Section Nineteen (19) Township twenty-nine (29) Range twenty-five (25) West of the Fourth Meridian, be established a Village; that the Village be given the name of A C M E; that Mr. J. Fisher Williams of Acme, Alberta, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first council of the Village and that the meeting for nomination of candidates for the office of councillor shall be held on Tuesday the Fifth day of July, 1910.
