MINISTERIAL ORDER

FORMATION OF THE VILLAGE OF AMISK

Whereas the undersigned being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the incorporation of a Village under the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952 and amendments thereto, have been substantially complied with, it is whereby ordered that the area described hereunder, namely:

Those portions of the north-west quarter of section 26, the south-west quarter of section 35, the north-east quarter of section 27 and the south-east quarter of section 34, township 41, range 8, west of the fourth meridian, described as follows:

- (1) Commencing at the point of intersection of the east boundary of the north-west quarter of section 26 and the south boundary of the surveyed road as shown on road plan 2238 E O.; thence westerly along said south boundary of the surveyed road to its intersection with the east boundary of Badger Street as shown on plans 7301 B Z and 1601 A A; thence south-westerly along the extension southerly of the east boundary of Badger Street to its intersection with the extension easterly of the south boundary of Third Avenue as shown on Plan 7301 B Z, thence north-westerly along the said extension and south boundary of Third Avenue to its intersection with the east boundary of Beaver Street as shown on Plan 7301 B Z; thence south-westerly along the extension of the east boundary of Beaver Street to its intersection with the west boundary of section 26, thence north along the west boundary of sections 26 and 35 to the intersection with the north boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway Grounds as shown on plan 7301 B Z, thence south-easterly along the north boundary of the Station Grounds to its intersection with the east boundary of the north-west quarter of section 26 and along the said east boundary to the point of commencement
- (2) Those portions of the north-west quarter of section 26 covered by Certificates of Title 31-I-38 and 146-C-124.
- (3) All that portion of the north-east quarter of section 27 which lies east of a line drawn parallel with and perpendicularly distant 360 feet westerly from the east boundary of the said quarter section
- (4) Those portions of the south-east quarter of section 34 covered by Certificates of Title 19-D-122, 205-Q-153 and 58-M-43
- (5) That portion of the surveyed road as shown on Road Plan 7908 A G lying south and adjacent to the parcel of land described under Certificate of Title 19-D-122.

All the above plans and Certificates of Title as registered in the Land Titles Office of the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton

Be and it is hereby withdrawn from the Municipal District of Provost No 52 and erected into a Village to be known as the Village of Amisk.

It is further ordered that a nomination meeting for the first election of a Council be held between the hours of eleven o'clock in the forenoon and twelve o'clock noon on Monday, January 9th, 1956, for the purpose of receiving names of candidates for the office of Councillors

It is further ordered that, if an election is necessary, the polling day shall be Monday, January 23rd, 1956, and that the election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, in that behalf

It is further ordered that the first meeting of the new council shall be held Monday, January 30th, 1956

This Order shall be effective as on and from the first day of January, 1956, except that for the purpose of Certificates of Assessment as required by sections 283 and 296 of The School Act, 1952 and section 73 of The Municipal Hospitals Act, this Order shall be deemed to have been in effect as of the 31st day of December, 1955.
