ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGES

Edmonton, Friday, May 6, 1910

Under the provisions of The Village Act, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order the establishment of that portion of the east half of Section Sixteen (16) Township Twelve (12) Range Twenty-Three (23) west of the Fourth Meridian that has been subdivided and registered in the South Alberta Land Titles Office as Plan No. 2605 X; as a Village, that the Village be given the name of Barons; that J. W. Brainard, of Barons, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first Council of the Village; and that the said election for a Council for the Village in question be held on Tuesday, the Seventeenth day of May, 1910.
