The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honorable the Minister of Public Works, dated September 29th.1906, wherein he states that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or rural Municipality, and that the said area contains not less than fifteen occupied dwelling houses, he has in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of "The Village Ordinance" caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post Office, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village after the expiration of thirty (30) days from the date of posting such notices:

The Minister further reports that such notices were posted at least thirty (30) days prior to the date hereof:

The Minister therefore begs to recommend that under the provisions of Section 4 of "The Village Ordinance," the South West quarter of Section thirty-one (31), Township forty-five (45) Range Seventeen (17) West of the Fourth Meridian be established a Village; that the Village be given the name of B A W L F; that Mr.O.E.Olesberg of Bawlf be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election

of the first Overseer for the Village, and that the said election for the Village in question be held on Friday the nineteenth (19th) day of October 1906.

The Executive Council concur in the recommendation of the Honorable the Minister of Public Works and advise that the same be acted upon.
