MINISTERIAL ORDER
—

FORMATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BOYLE

Whereas, the undersigned being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the incorporation of a village under the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, being chapter 97 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, and amendments thereto, have been substantially complied with, and

Whereas, it is necessary that provisions be made for the holding of an election

It is hereby ordered that the area described hereunder, namely

Firstly: That portion of the south-east quarter of section 4, township 65, range 19, west of the fourth meridian, lying south and east of the north-westerly limit of the Northern Alberta Railway right-of-way and station grounds, and

Secondly Legal subdivisions 4 and 5 of section 3, township 65, range 19, west of the fourth meridian; and

Thurdly. That portion of the north-east quarter of section 33, township 64, range 19, west of the fourth meridian, lying north of the south limit of Clintberg Avenue as same is shown on Registered Plan No 290H W and its production westerly to the west boundary of the said north-east quarter

be and it is hereby withdrawn from the Municipal District of Athabasca No 103 and erected into a village to be known as the Village of Boyle.

It is further ordered that a nomination meeting for the first election of a council be held between the hours of eleven o'clock in the forenoon and twelve o'clock noon on Monday, January 11th, 1954, for the purpose of receiving names of candidates for the office of councillors

It is further ordered that, if an election is necessary the polling day shall be Monday, January 25th, 1954, and that the election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, in that behalf

It is further ordered that the first meeting of the new council shall be held Monday, February 1st, 1954, at seven o'clock in the evening

This order shall be effective as on and from the 31st day of December, 1953.
