ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGE

Edmonton, Thursday, May 30, 1912.

Under the provisions of The Village Act His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order the establishment of the north-west quarter of Section 27 Township 45 Range 9 west of the Fourth Meridian as a Village; that the village be given the name of Irma; and that Warren Blaine Peterson, of Irma, be returning officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first council of the village, and that the meeting for the nomination of candidates for the office of councillors shall be held on Tuesday, the Twenty-eighth day of May, 1912.
